# **Job Description**

## **Domestic Assistant**

Responsible to – Domestic Team manager

Purpose of the job -

To ensure a high standard of cleanliness within the establishment

#### Major duties and responsibilities

- 1. To be directed by the Domestic Team Manager on areas that need cleaning
- 2. To carry out all general cleaning duties including the cleaning of the student's bedrooms, toilets and bathroom areas
- 3. To carry out, where necessary, simple food preparation and dining room duties
- 4. Washing kitchen and dining utensils
- 5. To carry out all duties with due regard to health and safety within the establishment.

#### Selection Criteria (skills, experience, qualifications if appropriate)

- Experience of carryout out general domestic duties
- An awareness of various cleaning methods, together with the appropriate use of detergents and cleaning agents and the health and safety implications involved
- Ability to use cleaning equipment, eg vacuum cleaners, floor polishers or the ability to learn
